### EXEMPTION(S) OR EXCEPTION(S)

The appropriate reason from paragraphs (A) to (C) of this rule shall be inserted in the unit or blanket exemption certificate when claiming exemption or exception from the Ohio sales or use taxes. Parenthetical numerals following some of the reasons are references to explanations under paragraph (D) of this rule

- (A) For resale in the form in which the same is, or is to be, received.(2)
- (B) A Sale
  - (1) To a church
  - (2) To a nonprofit organization operated exclusively for charitable purposes in this state (1)
- (C) Sales to a person licensed to conduct a food service operation under section 3732.03 of the Revised Code and Chapter 3701-21 of the Administrative Code of tangible personal property directly used in preserving, preparing, or serving food for human consumption, or directly used in maintaining or cleaning such property.(2)
- (D) Explanations.
  - (1) The law provides, "Charitable purposes means the relief of poverty, the improvement of health through the alleviation of illness, disease, or injury, the operation of an organization exclusively for the provision of professional, laundry, printing, and purchasing services to hospitals, charitable institutions, the operation of a home for the aged as defined in section 5703.13 of the Revised Code, the operation of a radio or television station operated as a noncommercial educational station, operation of a community or area center in which presentations in music, arts, dramatics, etc are made in order to foster public interest and education. Nothing in this division shall be deemed to exempt sales to any organization for use in the operation or carrying on of a trade or business."
  - (2) "Making retail sales" means the effecting of transactions wherein one party is obligated to pay the price and the other party is obligated to provide a service or to transfer title to or possession of the item sold, but it does not include the delivery of items thereafter nor the preliminary acts of promoting or soliciting the retail sales, other than the distribution of printed matter which displays or describes and prices the items offered for sale.
