Athletic Director: (Tony Hemmelgarn)

Tony asked for \$7,500 for his discretionary fund, which part of money will be used to put a flag pole at the softball field. Tony gave information regarding Cincinnati Red Spring Showcase, Tuesday, April 3, 7PM. \$2.00 from each ticket will be given back to the school.

Treasurer: (Mark Heggem)

Mark e-mailed all reports. We are in very good shape this year compared to last year. This is the first time we have funds available for Tony and others. TAB checking account has over \$138,000 currently. Concessions have been our largest fundraiser to date, however we still have Spartanrama coming up. Mark made a motion to vote giving Tony Hemmelgarn \$7,500 for his discretionary fund, All Programs. A vote taken with all in favor.
